## SMALL WORKS DEFINED

- Small Works Roster is an "invite only" solicitation process, used in lieu of publicly advertised processes
- Small works are public works projects with estimated costs less than \$350,000
- Small works projects are projects for:
  - Construction
  - Renovation
  - Repair

RCW 39.04.152(1)

- "Project" = one-time
- NOT
  - recurring
  - on-going
  - as needed
  - on-call
  - maintenance services !!!!!!!!!!

### AGENCY REQUIREMENTS TO USE A SMALL WORKS ROSTER

- Adopt resolutions and ordinances (RCW 39.04.151(4))
- Must establish procedures (RCW 39.04.152(1))
- Must have "invitation, bidding and contracting documents (RCW 39.04.152(3-4))
- With a competitive award it goes to the lowest responsive & responsible contractor (RCW 39.04.152(4)(a)(i))
- Must post award and bidding data publicly (RCW 39.04.152(6)


#### **Generate a Roster**

MRSC maintains 3 Roster types 1) vendors for goods and services, 2) consultants for personal services, architectural, and engineering services and 3) small works for small public works projects.

Procurements completed using an established roster must compete the work among the businesses in the relevant category and must follow contracting requirements outlined in RCW 39.04.

Your selected roster should be based on the procurement need. Local governments must follow their own policies and procedures and any relevant statues that may pertain to the type of procurement you are doing.

Any facilitation or support offered by MRSC is for administration of the applicable business list and is not procurement related.





# GENERATING A PROJECT SPECIFIC ROSTER

- Selecting "solicit businesses" is the point where you "lock in" your project-specific roster.
- This is the point where no additional contractors can be added.
- If you need to recruit or find more bidders, don't "solicit"

By selecting "solicit businesses" the project specific roster will change status to "active solicitation" indicating bidding and award is being conducted outside MRSC Rosters.

Agencies/local governments must only invite the businesses on the project specific roster and follow your local procedures for bidding and awarding public works project.

Keep this project specific roster in your procurement file.

### DIRECT CONTRACTING UNDER \$150,000

A *process* for small work projects estimated to cost under \$150,000

Intended to focus awards to OMWBE state certified small businesses first (rule of 6)

Requires a Rotation Policy - public agencies are responsible for writing their own

**Requires a Business Utilization Plan** 

## STATE CERTIFIED SMALL BUSINESSES



**PWSBE** - Public Works Small Business Enterprise - race and gender-neutral certification for small businesses owned by economically disadvantaged individuals

MBE - Minority Business Enterprise - owned by minorities

MWBE - Minority Women's Business Enterprise - owned by minority women

WBE - Women's Business Enterprise - owned by women

CBE - Combination Business Enterprise - owned by women and minorities

**SEDBE** - Socially and Economically Disadvantaged Business Enterprise - owned by non-minority men who are found to be socially and economically disadvantaged on a case-by-case basis

### **Steps for Direct Contracting**


- Interest email is sent to the next *rotated business* on the project-specific roster, asking if they you interested in bidding? No other bidders will be contacted unless the contractor declines, or an agreement is not reached on the price.
- 2. Email will contain the solicitation/bidding package: Invitation, Scope, Bid/Negotiation Form, etc.
- 3. Reach agreement
- 4. Award

## KEY TAKEAWAYS

Must have a Business Utilization Plan prior to soliciting

Must have a rotation policy

Must have an approach to invite and accept a bid from a single contractor

Only engage one contractor at a time

If a bid is not accepted/acceptable, have strong rationale and documentation as to why

### TIPS -MAXIMIZING RESULTS

### Engage your Roster (Bid Pool)

- Notify about upcoming projects be specific Project Type, Category and Sub-category
- Outreach via email or via electronic bidding
- Encourage your target businesses to update their roster application (more than once a year)
- Go to networking events (Meet the Agencies, Industry Associations - (AGC or ABC)
- Post on your website
- Promote with support organizations (APEX, OMWBE, Tabor 100, AWMB)
